MONEY PRINCIPLES: GIVE a little, SAVE a little, ENJOY a little, and always spend LESS than you make. (1 Tim. 6:17-19)

A. **ENJOY** a little (*God, who richly supplies us with all things to enjoy*)

☪ **SOURCE:** HE OWNS it all (1 Chron. 29:11, 14, 16)

☪ **SHARER:** HE gives us the ability to WORK and acquire it (1 Chron. 29:12; Deut. 8:18)

B. **SAVE** a little (Prov. 6:6-11; Prov. 21:5)

2 DANGERS:

1. **Hoarding** (= Greed) &
2. **Ignoring** (= Foolishness)

C. **GIVE** a little (1 Tim. 6:18)
