Too much about worship creates acrimony among fellow believers rather than adoration of God. What are key biblical principles to guide and establish our worship as people of God? Where are some of the places where we easily mix things up?

1. We view worship as **OPTIONAL** rather than essential.

☐ The question is not “Do we worship?” but “Who or what do we worship?”

2. We make worship about **US** rather than about God.

☐ The critical issue: **LOVING** God, not **LIKING** the event

☐ **STYLE** vs. **SUBSTANCE**

3. We make worship about **FORMS** rather than **HEART**.
(Isa. 1:11-15; Ps. 51:16-17; 1 Sam. 15:22; Hos. 6:6)

☐ The peril of self-styled worship

☐ Performance rather than **RESPONSE**

☐ The **BALANCE** of *spirit* and *truth* (Jn 4:23-24)
