# **Engage: The Sanctity of Life**

Tough Issues

#### What does sanctity of life actually mean?

- Human life is uniquely created by God and infinitely valuable to God.
- ⇒ Every human being possesses absolute worth which cannot be earned or forfeited, simply because we were made in the <u>image</u> of God.

#### **<u>UNIQUE</u>**: Mankind alone is created in the image of God.

Genesis 1:26-27

What is the image of God?

conclusion: "spiritual nature"

we have ability to think, feel and choose

**implies**: responsibility, self-consciousness & self-determination

summary: image = quality of personality

**impact**: because of man's uniqueness to his creator, his life is viewed <u>differently</u> by God than the life of other organisms.

**VALUABLE**: Man alone is infinitely valuable to God.

- 1. God's special **provision** for Adam (Gen 2:18-25)
- 2. God's special **relationship** with man (Gen 3:3-10, 31)
- 3. God's basis of **<u>capital</u>** punishment (Gen 9:6)
- 4. God's provision of cities of refuge (Josh 20:1-6)
- 5. God's provision of *redemption* (1 Tim 2:5-6)
