Servant VS Apostle

Paul's "heaven on earth" was **serving** others!

"You cannot become a servant of Christ until you realize that by nature you are a slave to **sin**." (James Boyce)

4 ways to become a slave in the biblical era

by birth

by conquest (taken captive & enslaved)

by debt (couldn't repay)

by **choice**

Serving leaders:

- ⇒ equip & **empower**, not encumber
- \Rightarrow liberate to **minister**, not stifle with structure

If we do not serve, we fight for rights.

Saints

2 kinds of people: "the saints & the ain'ts" (J Vernon McGee)

To become a saint, just as servant, one must first acknowledge his involuntary **slavery** - to sin.

Made holy in Christ - revolutionizes our identity.

Who am I in Christ?

I am a new **creation**. (2 Cor 5:17)

I am a **child** of God. (Jn 1:12; 1 Jn 3:1)

I am a joint **heir** with Christ. (Rom 8:17)

I am <u>alive</u> to God in Christ Jesus. (Rom 6:11)

I am <u>dead</u> to sin. (Rom 6:11)

I am <u>freed</u> from sin. (Rom 6:18)

I am a voluntary slave of **righteousness**. (Rom 6:18)

I am being <u>renewed</u> according to the image of Christ. (Col 3:10)

I am **crucified** with Christ. (Gal 2:20)

I am <u>chosen</u> in Christ. (Eph 1:4)

I am <u>adopted</u> into God's family. (Eph 1:5)

I am **redeemed**. (Eph 1:7)

I am **forgiven**. (Eph 1:7)

I am **loved**. (Jn 3:16; Rom 8)

I am **secure**. (Rom 8:38-39; 1 Jn 5:13)

I am free. (Jn 8:36)

I am a future resident of **heaven**. (Jn 14:2-3)
