2. Read 2 Peter 1:19-21. Why should we trust the Bible?
3. Read 2 Timothy 3:16-17. What is the Bible good for?
4. In your life, how have these two verses proven to be true? How has the Word of God worked in your life this week? What is God teaching you?
5. What are some falsehoods that are prevalent in our culture? What are some falsehoods you find yourself occasionally believing?
6. Read Ephesian 5:18. Why is being full of the Spirit compared to being drunk (hint: think of it in terms of decision making/control over your life)?
7. What is the difference between enduring a tough life and suffering for the gospel?
8. Why is it important to be full of the Spirit rather than wine when suffering for the gospel? Think specifically of 2 Timothy 4:3-4.
9. In your past, what is a difficult time you persevered through? What obstacles are you currently facing in your “race”?
10. According to scripture, what do you think heaven will be like? What do you think the rewards will be?
