

Potential Discussion Questions
Message: Engage JOY, Pt 11 (6-25-17)
The Sanctity of Life and Death, pt 33 (Phil. 1:19-26 & Selected)

1. Share a little about where your JOY is right now? What is feeding it? Impeding it?
2. In Hebrews 12:1-4, how did JOY intersect with suffering for Jesus? What does that say to you?
3. Read Revelation chapters 21:1 - 22:7. What stands out most to you? How does this stir your anticipation for the gains of physical death?
4. Review the four gains discussed that were noted in the outline (new in this message)? Which has the greatest impact on you? Why? How do (can) you cultivate a delight in these things?
5. How would you explain what it means to *be like* Jesus?
6. Do you know someone who is afraid of death? How does this study help bring peace and comfort to the certainty of death?
7. Paul states his conviction that he will continue living for a while for the *progress and joy in the faith* of the Philippians. How does that challenge you as you continue to live?
8. What would you like to discuss about this message that hasn't already been addressed?
9. What in this study gives you the most to think about? What will you do with it this week?
10. How would you like the group to pray for you with respect to your joy in life and death?
