1 Thessalonians 2:1-2	4. Fellowship in suffering is part of fully knowing Christ
 We suffer in personally <u>dying</u> to sin and crucifying our flesh with all the suffering it entails in body, mind, emotion, and spirit 	2 Corinthians 12:9-10
1 Peter 2:21, 24	 Current suffering is comforted with the hope of glory and the promise of ultimate <u>resurrection</u>.
## NOT I must suffer, but I am willing, if needed	1 Peter 4:16
Connections with fellowship, suffering and death	 Suffering does a refining, purifying, transforming work that leads us to <u>dependence</u> and holy living.
1. Overlapping themes / words with the Christ hymn	1 Peter 4:1-2
If true for Christ, why not for us?	Take it Home: Benefits of suffering
2. Suffering is something <i>granted</i> (1:29-30)	 Drives us deeply into the grace of God as it teaches us <u>obedience</u> (Heb 5:8)
