Engaging God's Compassion A study on God's compassion in the book of Jonah Jonah 4: Angry at God's Compassion

We should never <u>be angry</u> at God's compassion.

I. Jonah's anger is based on *opinion*, not *divine principles*. (4:1-4)

III. Jonah's anger at God's compassion is <u>self-</u> <u>condemning</u>. (4:10-11)

Ask yourself: do I deserve God's compassion?

Ask yourself: is it right for me to *be angry*?

II. Jonah's anger is based on *entitlement*, not *humility*. (4:5-9)

Ask yourself: am I acting out of *<u>entitlement</u>* or *<u>humility</u>?*
