

Potential Discussion Questions

Message: Know God - The Limits (2-11-18)

1. What are some areas in your life where you feel you buck up against limits? How do you respond those limits? Why?
2. Talk about the impact on our spiritual journey, both positive and negative, when we meet our limits in understanding and knowing God. Why is it important to come to grips with our limits?
3. What is the significance of Mt. 11:27 in our quest to know God? How do you balance the human responsibility to pursue knowing God with this verse?
4. Read Habakkuk chapters 1 and 2. Discuss what you learn by seeing the prophet interact with God. What limits did he face? How did he respond? What applies to you?
5. What is the difference for you between having answers and knowing God is present amid the questions? To which of these options do you most naturally bend? Why? How do you deal with the fact that we won't get answers to every question?
6. Think back through Romans 11:33-36 in its context. What strikes you? What are some implications of God's judgments and ways being unsearchable & unfathomable?
7. How does the incomprehensibility of God lead you to worship? Look at Psalm 109. What do you learn from David in this Psalm on this topic? What are his points of worship?
8. Talk about the four choices discussed at the conclusion of the message. Which one(s) grab your attention? Why? What is your response?
9. What would you like to discuss from this message that hasn't already been addressed?
10. What is your best take-away from this study? How do you want to pray for yourself in response?
