

Potential Discussion Questions

Message: Know God - Unique, Eternal (2-18-18)

1. Describe something you have done or seen that you thought was totally unique.
2. Review the passages dealing with God's "one and onlyness." What others would you add? How would you explain this concept to someone who is new to the Bible and its revelation of God?
3. How does idolatry undermine the character of God? What are idols (false objects of worship) that afflict our culture? churches? When we succumb to false gods, we cannot experience genuine worship. How can/should we counteract that?
4. What are some important implications from the fact that God revealed Himself through His WORD rather than through images and objects?
5. The message presented for implications of God's uniqueness. Which of them stood out most to you? Why? What others do you think of?
6. How would you explain the connection between God's character as unique and the biblical statements that there is only one way to God (e.g., Jn 14:6)?
7. We listed off 10 things explained in Scripture as eternal or everlasting. How do these reflect and require God to be eternal? Read through some of the passages with a verse or 2 (at least) of context. How does this expand your understanding and appreciation of God's eternity?
8. Why and how can we find comfort in the assurance that an eternal God will establish His purpose and accomplish His good pleasure (Isa 46:9-10)?
9. In what way does God's eternity touch you most in a personal way?
10. What would you like to discuss from this message that hasn't already been addressed?
11. What is your best take-away from this study? How do you want to pray for yourself in response?
