

Potential Discussion Questions

Message: Know God - Omnipresent (4-15-18)

1. Look up the lyrics to the song *Every Step You Take*. What of this could biblically represent God's omnipresence? What doesn't fit?
2. What is pantheism? What is the difference between that view and God as omnipresent?
3. The message presented a list of the implications of God's omnipresence. Which stood out most to you? Why? What others would you add?
4. What difference would it make if God were not omnipresent? How would that impact your relationship with Him and your daily living?
5. Read Psalm 139:7-12 aloud and consider the specific descriptions David gives. How do they make his point that it is impossible to get away from God?
6. What are common ways people try to escape and run from God? Have you ever tried? What did you discover/learn?
7. How do you see the interconnectedness of omniscience, omnipresence and omnipotence in Psalm 139? How do you see this leading into his discussion of preborn life?
8. Talk about the significance of the 7 different words or phrases that David uses to speak of God's creative work in the womb (vs 13-16). What do they tell you? Which one(s) are most striking? How does it impact you to consider God's in utero activity in your life? How should this passage impact our view of convenience abortion?
9. Verses 17-18 reveal David's response to God's thoughts toward him. How do you resonate with what he says? How would you describe how your heart is responding to these truths? (Extra "fun": read verses 19-24 and interact on David's response.)
10. What would you like to discuss from this message that hasn't already been addressed?
11. What is your best take-away from this study? How does it spur you to pray?
