### Message: Know God - Call His Name, pt 2, Eternal Father (12-19-18)

1. What are some things you felt took a long time? Why do you think they still stand out to you?
2. What is a gift you have given or received that really lasted a long time?
3. How do you conceive of time and eternity? How do you get your arms around the fact that God is totally above time?
4. What are some implications that God knows the end from the beginning yet still works with us in a time-bound system?
5. Do you find it easy or difficult to live with eternity in view?
6. The message discussed several ways that "Eternal Father" Jesus impacts us and our Christmas. Which one connects with you best where you are in life right now?
7. Is there something in your life that compels you to seek God's eternal help? For what specific need does Hebrews 2:18 indicate Jesus will come to our aid?
8. Why do you think Hebrews 2:16 distinguishes between the help God gives to angels opposed to men?
9. Read Psalm 90. What insights do you find to bring time and eternity together? How do you observe that God has set eternity in our hearts (Ecc 3:11)? Why is this important?
10. How do you practically deal with expectations and expectation busts? Where do you need to guard yourself in this regard during the Christmas season? What insight does this study give you that can help you keep the right focus?
11. What would you like to discuss that hasn't already been engaged in this study?
12. Spend some time celebrating that we are part of the eternal family of God.
