Two prices to pay (1-4)

Emotional & physical disruption or pain (1-3)

If necessary, would you go to jail for the Gospel?

Who cares for the nursery? (4)

3 needs: equipping, courage, encouraging

## Religion vs true faith

Religion restricts rather than <u>releases</u> the power of God. (5-12)

The heavy weights (5-6)

What's your power base? (7)	God's confounding (13)
Filled with the Spirit (8)	
Divine Sarcasm (9)	Religion is not excited about how God is using you, but fearful of how it might undermine its power & control.
The cripple healed by the cast-off stone (10-12)	
	Religious stifling. (15-17)
Religion fights to save its power/place; true faith fights to preserve/promote the <b>power</b> of God.	
	Religion legislates rather than <u>liberates</u> (v 18-22)
	Often the issue is control = You can't.
Religion presses conforming rather than <u>transforming</u> . (12-17)	
Today's conformity: no exclusivity	Respectful freedom = We must. We <u>submit</u> .
