

Suggested Discussion Questions for 1/31/20201

Walk the (Covid-19) Wilderness with Moses, pt 18: God's Top 10, pt 4 (Ex 20:12-14)

1. How do you think about the forces that are shaping you as a person, especially your inner being? Which do you see as most important?
2. What "loves" in your life were dominant 5 years ago? Now? What has made the difference?
3. What are your first impulses about "loving your neighbor"? Do you see places you feel good about how you are doing? Are there areas where you feel more struggle?
4. How do you interact with the explanation in the message of "honor your father and mother..."? What stood out most?
5. How does seeing God as the giver and sustainer of life clarify the "never murder" command?
6. There are many current social/ethical issues related to life and the sanctity of life. What is one that matters to you? How does our discussion help you understand or explain a biblically-based conclusion?
7. Does it make sense to you that fidelity, not sex, is the heart of the issue adultery? How does it impact your understanding and response?
8. Look up some passages where God uses the language of marital infidelity and harlotry to describe the spiritual condition of His people? What do these reveal about God's heart? How do they motivate our fidelity?
9. How have you seen lives crushed by the pursuit of false intimacy? Though it seems people are resistant to discuss it, why is it important? How can we spur each other to the pursuit of genuine intimacy with God and others?
10. What would you like to discuss from this message that hasn't been addressed?
