

## **Suggested Discussion Questions for 5/30/2021**

### **What You Believe Matters, Acts 18:24-30**

1. Share a time in your life when a false belief or incomplete understanding needed correction.
2. Do a little study on your own about Apollos to supplement the message. What would you include in a brief biography based upon Scripture?
3. What did Apollos get right? How would you explain what was missing? Which of these qualities most encourages you? Most challenges you?
4. It's a leadership hazard: if people don't like the result, they attack the process. Still, methods matter. What do we learn about the process of correction from Aquilla and Priscilla?
5. Share a time when a fresh or corrected understanding of Scripture brought new opportunity in your life.
6. How do you discern if you (or others) are takers rather than contributors?
7. What help do you feel God is stirring in your heart to contribute in your current life-stage?
8. Where do you feel your contribution is making the greatest impact? Are there any adjustments you feel led to make to increase your impact?
9. What would you like to discuss from this passage that hasn't been addressed yet?
10. What is your greatest take-away from this study?
