### **Trials, pt 2 (Acts 25:1-27)**

1. What do you consider some key twists in the plot in the story of your life?
2. What do you discover about the way evil operates in verses 1-7?
3. Where are you prone to let your emotions press your faith to unhealthy places?
4. How does Festus' attempts to "do a favor" for the Jews play into this passage? In what way(s) might it have been self-serving?
5. How can we be prone to twist truth or conviction to grant someone a favor?
6. Why is verse 12 especially significant in this drama of Paul's journey and witness?
7. Talk through the 4 fallacies of adventuring with God presented in the message. What struck you? Which one(s) seem most relevant to your current situation?
8. Is there a new adventure with God that you are in or see on your horizon? How are you embracing it? Where might or are you struggling with it?
9. How have you seen your needs, insecurities, uncertainties or fears become the point at which God takes you on an adventure (new growth or service)?
10. What in this study challenges you to change or progress in your walk with God?
11. How can the group pray for you in the coming week? (share and pray for each other)
