

## **When Life Crashes** (Acts 27:1-44)

### **Airplane falls out of the air**

### **Ignore God's wisdom to your peril** (1-20)

It's easy to put too much confidence in our own wisdom.

The majority is often wrong.

In the midst of crisis, hope gets stretched.

Lots of "stuff" seeks to steal our hope and dump us on the shoals.

No God, it's devastation; Know God, it stirs dependence.

The problem is not the crashes. They're inevitable. The problem comes in navigating them without God, or ignoring His instruction, or discounting His promises.

### **God breaks into our chaos – revelation and purpose** (21-26)

2 keys to hope:

God's revelation

It's not declaring what I want, then saying it's from God.

Note: Paul affirms both relationship and worship

Faith (trusting what we know He said)

### **Sometimes we just crash forward.** (27-44)

"Crash forward" =

Multiple paths

Delivered from the storm

Delivered through the storm
