## Suggested Discussion Questions for 10/31/2021 Unstoppable (Acts 28)

- 1. What do you think of storm-chasers? Why do we chase things that will lead to destruction and loss?
- 2. How would you describe what happened with Paul on Malta? What surprises you most?
- 3. What tempts you to make quick decisions about the reality of people or events around you? How do you balance "your gut" or biblical discernment into your assessments?
- 4. Do you see any indication in the text that Paul did or did not share the gospel with the people on Malta? Why do you think Luke included and omitted what he did in this account?
- 5. Is there any place where you need "an extra dose of courage" right now?
- 6. When Paul gets to Rome, the clarity of his gospel activity is again introduced. What do you learn of Paul's activity and priority in verses 16-31?
- 7. What passage from Isaiah does Paul quote in this section? Why might this have effectively supported his message? What other New Testament passages use similar language?
- 8. If you have time, do a little research on attempts throughout history to silence the gospel and destroy the Bible. Share them and reflect on God's faithful preservation and protection of His people and revelation. How does this encourage you?
- 9. Some people suggest the current Church is Acts 29. How might this be true?
- 10. What stood out to you in this chapter that hasn't been addressed yet?
- 11. What in this study challenges you to change or progress in your walk with God?
