

Suggested Discussion Questions for 12/12/2021

Hidden Figures, pt 1, (Luke 2:36-38)

1. Who do you consider to be hidden figures in your life story? How are they important?
2. Anna's piety and position (both as widow and prophetess) seem important to Luke in this account. What reasons do you see for that?
3. New Testament teaching speaks of widows indeed (1 Tim 5:5). Do you think we have such people in the church today? Why or why not?
4. What evidences of Anna's devotion do you see in this text? How are you encouraged or challenged by them?
5. What is a specific step you can take this week to advance your devotion to Christ? (i.e., how might you both alter and altar?)
6. What do you see as the difference between costly and not expensive, as explained in the message? How does this relate to your discipleship?
7. How has or can waiting inspire hope for you? For others?
8. Which of the verses on hope and waiting mentioned in our study most connected with you? How and why?
9. What stood out to you in this study that hasn't been addressed yet or you would like to discuss further?
10. How would you like others to pray for you during the Christmas season? Take some time to pray for each other for the things shared.
