Suggested Discussion Questions for 1/16/2022 Good News (Romans 1:18-32)

1.	What are your thoughts when you hear the word "wrath"?
2.	Do a little study. How/where is "wrath" used in the New Testament? How would you define it?
3.	How does creation reveal God? (What does Paul say in our text? What other passages help flesh this out and what do they add?)
4.	What is the significance of v 20?
5.	Failing to give God the glory and gratitude He deserves leads to the suppression of truth and the proliferation of evil. How does Paul explain the "great exchange" process? How do you see this in yourself and the world in general?
6.	Paul describes awful things that happen when we seek/worship God's gifts rather than God Himself. What are those he notes? How can we as believers stumble into similar patterns?
7.	Three times Paul says God "gives people up" – He releases them to keep chasing the lies they exchange for the truth. What does this tell us about God? About mankind?
8.	What connection do you see between this passage and 1 Corinthians 5:1-8? Even when God gives people up to their choices, what is His desire?
9.	What does it mean to find our identity in Christ? How does/can that help you chart and keep your course grounded in the truth?
10	. What have you learned about God, yourself or others that will spur you forward in your spiritual relationship with God and encourage your witness for the gospel?
