

**Suggested Discussion Questions for 4/10/2022 Message:  
Free Yet Battling (Romans 7:1-25)**

1. How would you describe the tension between being free in Christ and the ongoing battle with sin?
2. How does Paul use the analogy of marriage in this text? What is his conclusion?
3. Reread chapters 6 & 7. What is similar? What is different? What is the overall point?
4. How does Paul use his own experience (testimony) in chapter 7? What points is he seeking to establish that help us live our life in Christ?
5. How does Paul address that death to sin and the law by faith in Christ does not lead to the immediate eradication of their pull?
6. Several reasons were given for why this chapter likely represents Paul's ongoing battle after he came to faith in Christ. Which are most compelling to you? What would you add? What do you see as indicators that he might be speaking of his life before faith in Christ?
7. Paul's description of this battle is extreme. When/where do you feel the battle? What help does this text give is in pressing forward to victory?
8. Is there a particular battle where you are struggling right now? How might the group pray for and encourage you?
9. What is your best take-away from this study?
10. What in this passage would you like to discuss further?
