Key principles

We do not increase sin to increase grace.

Grace liberates us from involuntary bondage to voluntary slavery, not absolute freedom.

It's a choice predicated upon the nature of grace and the undeniable result.

Our willful participation - presentation revisited (19)

What's the difference? "Great in every way."

<b>Slavery to Sin</b>	<b>Slavery to righteousness</b>
<b>Roots:</b> Adam 1	Last Adam
<b>Operating syst:</b> law	grace
<b>Basis:</b> obligation (no choice)	voluntary
<b>Effect:</b> impurity; lawlessness	righteousness
<b>Motivation:</b> satisfy flesh	glorify God; transformation
<b>Result:</b> death	life, liberty & sanctification
