

**Suggested Discussion Questions for 5/22/2022 Message:
It's All Good (Romans 8:31-39)**

1. What is an insecurity that troubles you? How do you battle/overcome it?

2. Romans 8 gives a great foundation for our security in Christ. Rehearse its main points. Which one ministers most to you personally?

3. Meditate on the truth that *God is for us*. What comes to your mind?

4. What contextual evidence do you find that God *graciously giving us all things* (v 32) is not supportive of the prosperity gospel?

5. Reflect on all the things Paul raises that cannot separate us from God's love (vs 35-39). What stands out most to you? How does this undergird your security?

6. How do you see Paul's quotation of Psalm 44:22 explaining and enhancing his argument? What questions does it raise, especially in the broader context of the Psalm?

7. John speaks of believers as overcomers in his first letter. How do those verses enhance our understanding of being *more than conquerors*? (Start with 2:13-14, 4:4, 5:4-5 and their surrounding verses.)

8. Paul speaks strongly of our security. How does this help us face doubts about our faith?

9. What stands out to you most in this passage? What is your greatest take away?

10. What would you like to discuss on this passage that hasn't been covered?
