

Suggested Discussion Questions for 6/12/2022 Message:
What's Up with the Jews?, pt 3 (Romans 10:18-11:36)

1. If you were to give one word to prove the truth of the Bible other than “Israel,” what would it be?
2. How does the presence of a remnant encourage us with all the unfaithful Gentiles? How might Paul argue for it?
3. In what ways does hardening extend the time for people to come to repentance and faith?
4. The process of making Israel jealous is part of the mystery of the gospel. It blends together the choice of God and the response of man. How would you trace this divine plan through Scripture?
5. How does Paul use the metaphors of the firstfruits and the root to help explain the future of Israel in God’s plan?
6. Paul’s discussion is firmly rooted in the faithfulness of God. What are some of the passages that underscore that God is faithful and keeps His promises? How does His covenant with Abraham fit into this?
7. What encourages and challenges you in the doxology of verses 33-36.
8. In what ways do you or can you live the assurance of v 36 – that all things are “from Him and through Him and to Him?”
9. What stirs your heart in chapters 9-11 to greater faith and obedience?
