

**Suggested Discussion Questions for 9/11/2022 Message:
Good News in Shoe Leather, pt 9, Romans 14:13-23**

1. Share a spiritual insight or growth point from your summer.
2. Since your last group meeting we've covered some important truth in Romans 12-14. What is something that struck, encouraged or challenged you in these chapters?
3. When you look at the world, is it more black, white or gray? What leads you to your conclusion?
4. Has there ever been a situation where you felt another believer caused you to stumble? Or you caused another to stumble? What happened and was the situation ever set right?
5. How do you see people demanding freedom that hurts rather than builds up?
6. What did Paul mean when he said abuse of liberty might *destroy the work of God*?
7. Do you agree that one can be right and wrong at the same time? If so, how would you explain it in light of our text?
8. Have you ever encountered a professional weaker brother? What clued you in that this was the case? How is discerning their state important to healthy relationships in working out differences of conviction over non-essentials?
9. How does *whatever is not of faith is sin* guide, ground and liberate your walk with Jesus?
10. How might you be called upon to *bear with the failings of the weak*?
11. What would you like to discuss that hasn't yet been addressed?
12. What is your greatest take-away from this study?
