## Suggested Discussion Questions for 9/17/2023 Message: Thriving with the Thessalonians, pt 6, (1 Thes. 4:1-8)

- 1. Share a way God has been recently stirring your heart to seek and follow Him.
- 2. Sometimes we just want to ride on our past, assume we've come far enough, or slack off for a bit. What helps you respond to Paul's "excel still more" encouragement in this passage?
- 3. Living to please God seems like such a simple and obvious goal. Why and how does it become difficult?
- 4. Read Matthew 28:18-20. How does this link conversion with conformity to Christ? What is another passage that does the same? Why is it vital that we don't separate them?
- 5. Paul makes our sexuality a matter of sanctification. How is this significant to us, especially in a culture that generally views it very differently?
- 6. What do you see as the most important teaching in this text about God's plan for our sexuality?
- 7. Paul gives 3 motivations for living with sanctified sexuality. What are they? Why is each important?
- 8. How is verse 8 helpful in addressing a culture that takes a very cavalier attitude toward their sexual practices?
- 9. What would you like to discuss from this passage that hasn't been addressed?
- 10. What is one step you would like to take this week to go forward in your walk with God?
