1.	What is your visceral response to the word "obedience"? Why?
2.	Why is it that we proclaim to love God but choose not to obey Him? What is the disconnect?
3.	Explain the distort and deceive process of the serpent in Genesis 3. What are some ways you have encountered this in your own life?
4.	We've all faced times when our willer/wanter gives in to temptation. What do you learn from Genesis 3 and the balance of this message that will help keep it activated to obedience?
5.	Describe how unbelief and pride make us vulnerable to disobedience.
6.	Read Exodus 39 and 40. How many times in these 2 chapters do you find something like "Moses (or Israel) did just as the Lord commanded"? Why is this significant in the passage? Why is it significant in your life?
7.	Read and reflect on Numbers 14 and Deuteronomy 11. What strikes you most about obedience and disobedience in these accounts? What principles for your personal obedience stand out to you?
8.	How would you explain and encourage someone who is struggling in their spiritual walk to embrace the blessing of obedience?
9.	Is there an area where your obedience is being challenged or flagging? How could the group pray for you?
