

## **Suggested Discussion Questions for 2/25/2024**

### **Message: Great Fathers, pt 2**

1. What is a life lesson you learned from being in a hard place?
2. Read the statements of God's covenant with Abraham in Genesis 12 and 15. What is similar? What is unique? Where do you discover its 3 fundamental elements: land, seed and blessing?
3. Discuss why God's covenants are so significant in the redemption drama of the Bible.
4. God's promise to Abraham was not directly to us, but it was for us. How are we beneficiaries.
5. Share a biblical promise you claim and why it's important to you.
6. Share your response to building altars and pitching tents. What are some ways you see people (or yourself) getting these reversed?
7. Do you see times in your life where following God seemed a bit crazy? If so, share one.
8. When you read Genesis 22:1-14, what stands out to you? How does it challenge you to trust God?
9. How do you respond to God testing your faith? What are some other biblical examples of where God tested people's faith?
10. Is there a place in your life where you are currently stretched to trust God? How does reflecting on the sufficiency of His power help you (see Heb 11:17-19)?
11. How would you like the group to pray for you in the application of this study? (share, then pray)
