- 7. Do you see times in your life where following God seemed a bit crazy? If so, share one.
- 8. When you read Genesis 22:1-14, what stands out to you? How does it challenge you to trust God?
- 9. How do you respond to God testing your faith? What are some other biblical examples of where God tested people's faith?
- 10. Is there a place in your life where you are currently stretched to trust God? How does reflecting on the sufficiency of His power help you (see Heb 11:17-19)?
- 11. How would you like the group to pray for you in the application of this study? (share, then pray)
