

Suggested Discussion Questions for 4/7/2024

Message: Bible Greats – Passover

1. How does (or can) thinking about the biblical accounts as drama help you engage and connect to the account?
2. When you put yourself into the Passover account, where do you most identify? What emotions does it evoke for you?
3. When you reread the origin of Passover (Ex 11:1-12:14), what most grips your attention?
4. See if you can find some of the other passages where Passover is referenced. What do they add to your understanding?
5. When you consider how dramatic and significant was to Israel, why do you think they so frequently failed to keep the annual remembrance?
6. What does Israel's forgetfulness speak to us about our own forgetfulness of significant spiritual moments in our lives?
7. Beside your new birth, is there an especially meaningful spiritual event that you like to remember?
8. How does God use Israel's redemption from Egypt to motivate their loyal obedience? What parallel do you see with our redemption in Christ? (What NT passages indicate this?)
9. What is your greatest take-away in this study on Passover?
10. What would you like to discuss that hasn't been raised in your interaction on Passover?
