

## **Suggested Discussion Questions for 5/5/2024**

### **Message: Great Words for Salvation**

1. Share one of your favorite verses on salvation.
2. Why do you believe the Bible uses so many different terms that describe/explain salvation?
3. Look at the verses shared in the message regarding rescue/deliverance. What stands out most to you?
4. What specific things are we rescued from? How do these help us understand the scope of our salvation in Christ?
5. Rescues are typically intense, emotional, stressful, and leave deep impressions. How does it impact us when we embrace fully the necessity and extent of our rescue?
6. We only scratched the surface on passages that speak of redemption and ransom. In addition to the passages referenced in the message, find some others and read them together.  

How do these passages explain and underscore that we have been purchased and a price (ransom) has been paid?

How do these passages reflect what Jesus has done? Why is His role so important?
7. Consider the implications or profound truths connected to redemption. What is most significant to you personally and why?
8. The message noted 3 responses we can/should have in light of our redemption. Share your responses to them.
9. Christ did not redeem us to have us live as slaves. What strikes you in Galatians 4:8-5:1? Why is this important to living out the freedom and fullness of our redemption?
