When they sinned:

Option 1: Rev. 12:4

Option 2: Gen. 6:4; Jude 6

Where they were sent: "Tartarus"

He judged the wicked in the days of Noah (2:5a.)

He judged the wicked in Sodom and Gomorrah
(2:6; compare Genesis 18-19).

Side 2: He is the Rescuer of the Righteous (2:5b; 7-8)

He protected Noah (2:5b).

He rescued Lot (2:7-8).
